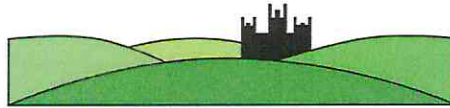

Dear Parent/Guardian,

We hope that your child is enjoying their last weeks of primary school and is excited about joining The Canterbury Academy on Tuesday 3rd September 2019. In preparation for the new academic year, The Canterbury Academy offers you and your child opportunities to become familiar with our school and its systems. We are currently preparing to visit our Year 6 students at their primary schools and outline our procedures. There are three key dates for your diary:

Induction Evening	Monday 24 th June 2019	7.00pm start (uniform ordering/sales available from 5.00pm)
Induction Days	Thursday 4 th & Friday 5 th July 2019	9.00am-2.45pm (the uniform shop will be open from 8.30am – 9.30am and from 2.30pm – 3.30pm)

Induction Evening is for students, parents and guardians. Students will have the opportunity to meet their peers and some of their teachers. The students will meet potential classmates for Year 7 and discuss arrangements and expectations for the year ahead. There is the opportunity for you to find out more about the range of opportunities available to your children and meet a number of key personnel who will be working closely with Year 7.

At Induction Evening there will also be an opportunity for you to order and purchase uniform and PE kit from 5.00pm until 7.00pm before the evening commences with the Executive Principal's speech. As you can appreciate with over 200 students coming into year 7 in September the demand on the evening is quite high. For your own benefit, therefore, it is suggested that you arrive as early as you can. We do stock uniform so if you would rather be fitted on an alternate date, the school shop will also be open on the two induction days (see information above) and from Monday 15th July 2019 at the following times: 08.30am-3.30pm until Friday 19th July 2019 or from Thursday 1st August 2019 until Friday 30th August 2019 from 10am until 3pm.

Induction Days are for students only. Students will follow a timetable over the two days and experience a variety of lessons. They should attend in their primary school uniform and be equipped with a blue or black pen, pencil, ruler and eraser; if they are able to bring trainers for PE it would be very helpful. The students will also have the opportunity to learn the routine


In partnership with Simon Langton  Grammar School for Boys to provide a grammar school band for boys and girls in a comprehensive school for all the talents

of school meals by buying their lunch. The cost of the meal is presently £2.00 for a main course; desserts and drinks are an additional £1.00 each; and pasta pots are £2.00. Students who would prefer to bring their own lunch are welcome to do so. Students who are currently entitled to free school meals will be provided for.
