INTRODUCTION

- A. The Parties entered into a funding agreement dated 6TH October 2010 ("the Funding Agreement") relating to the establishment, maintenance and funding of an independent school known as The Canterbury Primary School
- B The Parties now wish to vary and amend the terms of the Funding Agreement and wish to record their agreement as to such variations/amendments to the Funding Agreement by this Deed.

LEGAL AGREEMENT

- Any word or phrase used in this Deed shall, if that word or phrase is defined in the Funding Agreement, bear the meaning given to it in the Funding Agreement.
- 2. The Secretary of State and the Academy agree that with effect from the date of this Deed the Funding Agreement shall be amended in accordance with Schedule 1 to this Deed.
- 3. As varied by this Deed, the Funding Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.

Schedule 1

Amendments to the Funding Agreement

 Clause 2.5 of the Funding Agreement Schedule 1 of the Supplemental Agreement shall be replaced with:

Pupils

2.5 The planned capacity of The Canterbury Primary School is 435 in the age range 4 to 11, which for the avoidance of doubt includes pupils with designated places pursuant to clause 2.6

SEN unit

- 2.6 The Academy must operate designated places reserved for pupils with SEN (SEN Unit or Resourced Provision) with up to 15 planned places for pupils with High Needs ASD in the age range 4 to 11
- 2.7The Secretary of State may at any time determine that the SEN Unit or Resourced Provision should cease to operate. In making such a determination, the Secretary of State will
 - 2.7.1 consider the views of the Academy and relevant LAs (in their strategic role in the commissioning of SEN provision); and
 - 2.7.2 consider how his determination will affect the LAs' ability to secure suitable SEN provision for children in the area.
